1. **CO'S CORNER:** There are three vitally important things to remember this drill. Firstly, we will be in Dress Whites season by drill weekend. Secondly, mandatory swim qualifications are this drill so ensure you bring a swimsuit (one-piece for females) that is conservative in nature. Lastly, there will be an early dismissal Saturday for the Easter Holiday. Please be on time and ready to drill because there is a lot to do in a little time.

2. **ADMINISTRATION DEPT NOTE:**

a. Enrollments for Cadets who expire will not be renewed unless fees are paid. Additionally, if you do not wish to participate in the program any longer, please contact the Commanding Officer. The following personnel ID Cards are expired or about to expire:
